

CASALE IN CHIANTI

A combination of rural charm, comfort, and technology. This private house is a jewel of gentle renovation.

As the original building was a farm, the project was based on the concept of using natural and simple materials. The living rooms are expansive and open and the big kitchen, separated from them only by a big brickwork oven, is part of the large space and serves as a friendly meeting point. On the same level, there is a guest bedroom and two bathrooms. On the second floor, the sleeping area consists of a master bedroom and two children's rooms. Each room has a private bathroom. Great attention was given to the used materials – kitchen plans and sinks are made of concrete, the kitchen furniture is covered by sheets of aged iron, while the rooms feature traditional lime plaster.
